COMMUNITY CONNECTION

The Lion's Head Lookout offers one of Bruce County's most spectacular views, with towering cliffs overlooking the brilliant blue waters of Georgian Bay. Part of the Bruce Trail, this scenic destination has become a favourite for hikers, photographers, and families looking to experience the natural beauty of the Niagara Escarpment.

Standing at the entrance to Big Tub Harbour since 1885, the Big Tub Lighthouse has guided ships safely into Tobermory for well over a century. Today, visitors can stroll the harbour, admire the historic lighthouse, watch boats arrive and depart, and enjoy views of the crystal-clear waters that make this area famous.

Located along the banks of the Saugeen River, Paisley's Rotary Park is a favourite gathering place for families. The park features a splash pad, playground, picnic areas, and plenty of green space to enjoy. Its location near downtown also makes it an easy stop while exploring the historic village of Paisley.

Scottish Highland Cows



With their long shaggy hair and impressive curved horns, Scottish Highland cows are one of the most recognizable farm animals in the world! Originally from the Highlands of Scotland, these hardy cattle are built to handle cold, windy weather. Their thick, fluffy coats keep them warm in winter, and many people are surprised to learn they are usually gentle and curious animals.

Highland cows come in several colours, including reddish-brown, black, yellow, white, and even silver.

Fun Fact: That shaggy "bang" isn't just for looks— it helps protect their eyes from rain, snow, and bright sunshine! If you ever spot Highland cows at a local farm, be sure to admire them from a safe distance. They're a favourite with visitors and are always ready for a photo!



Sheep Smarts!

Sheep have amazing memories! They can recognize dozens of faces, including other sheep and even people they've met before. They also enjoy staying close to their family and friends in the flock.

Horses Can't Burp

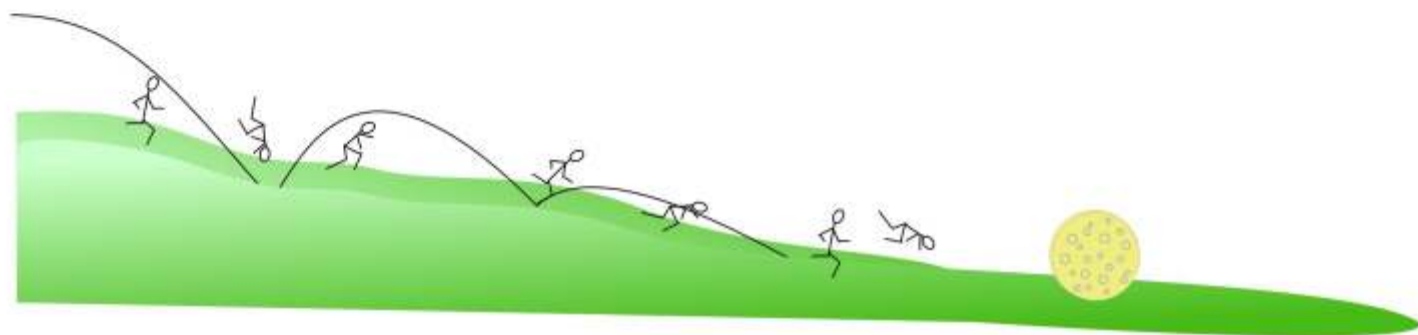
Unlike many animals, horses can't burp or vomit. That's why sudden changes in diet or eating too much grain can sometimes lead to serious stomach problems.

WORLD OF WONDER

Cooper's Hill Cheese-Rolling and Wake - Usually happens in May
In Gloucestershire, England, people chase rolling cheese wheels down a steep hill. This famous event involves a round wheel of Double Gloucester cheese rolling down the hill, while racers sprint, tumble, slide, and bounce after it. The hill is so steep that many people fall before reaching the bottom. The cheese can reach speeds over 100 km/hr! The winner gets to keep the cheese! The tradition is believed to be hundreds of years old. People travel from many countries just to watch or participate.

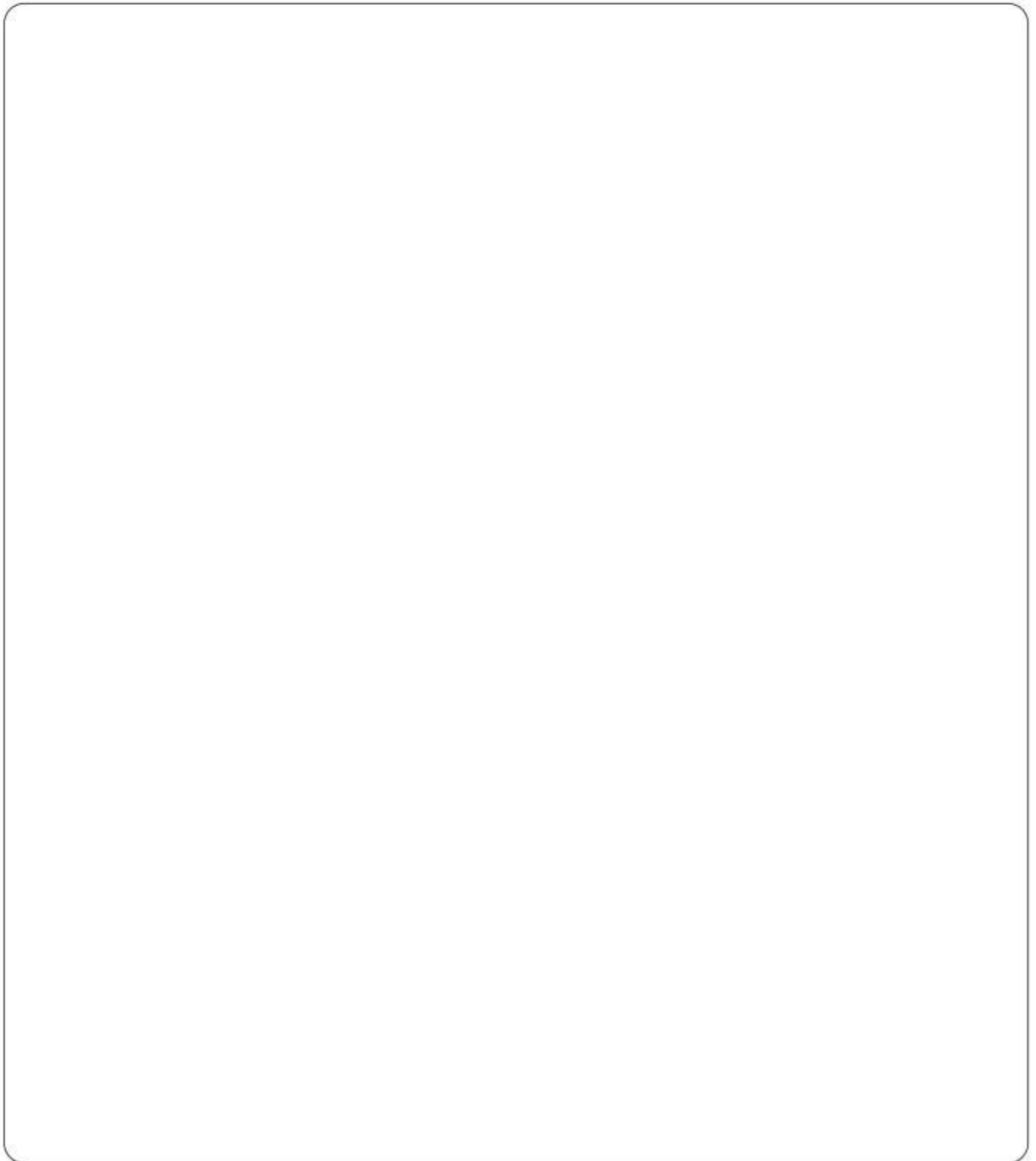

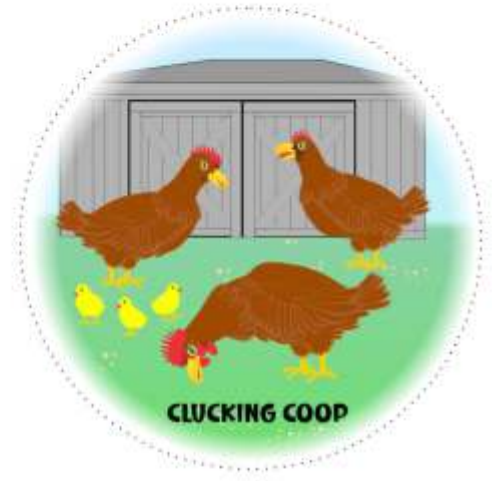
MAP OF FEELINGS

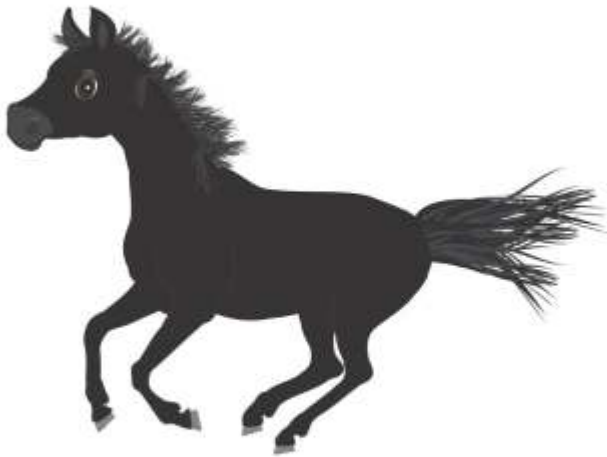

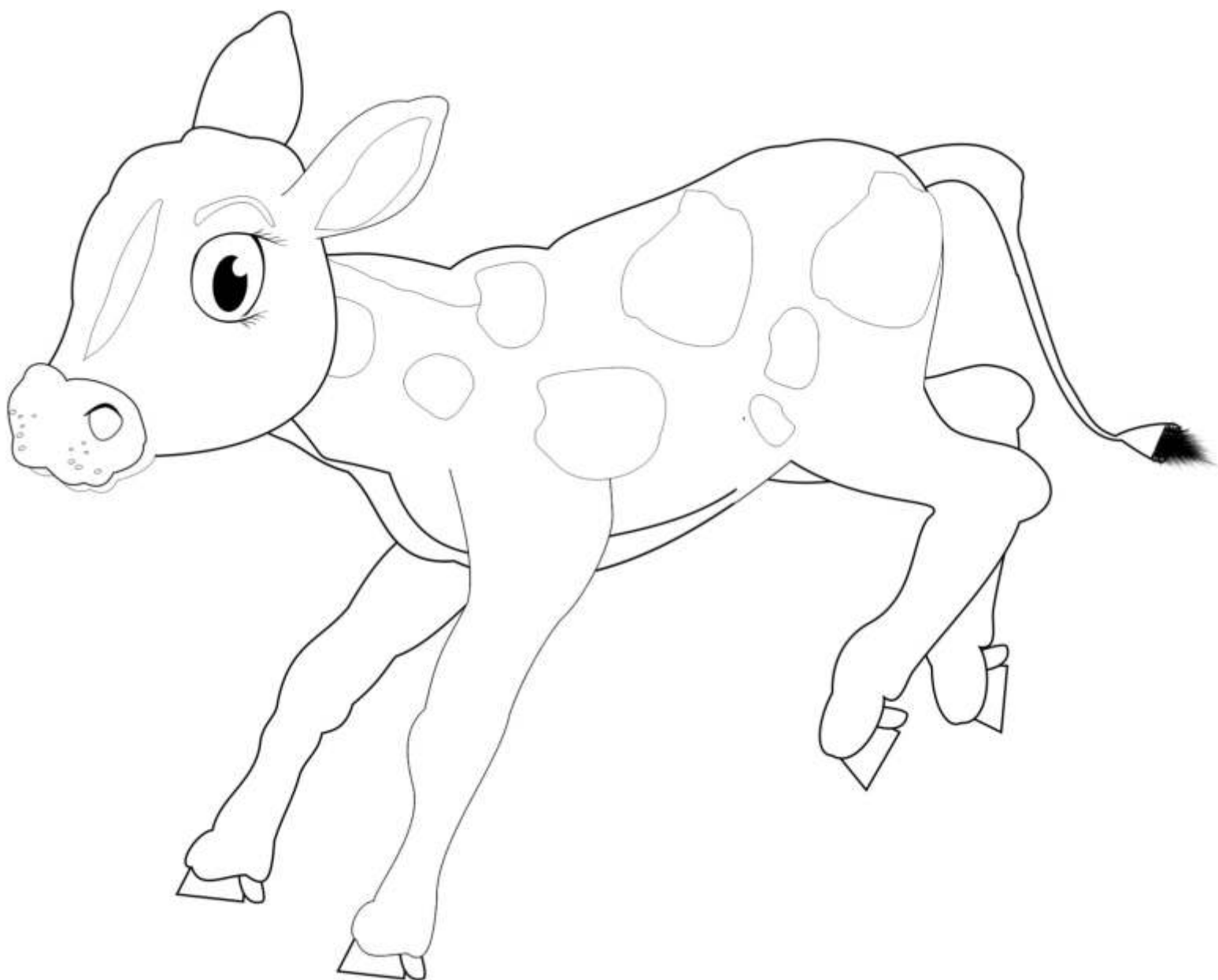
